

## Holy Family Parish Guidelines for CYO Athletics

1. All CYO participants must be attending Religious Formation classes at the parish or be registered as home schooled students.
  2. CYO participant families must be in good standing as members of the parish – you must be an active member of the parish.
  3. If an athlete would like to participate in a sport that is not offered at Holy Family, that athlete **must** participate with the bordering parish that offers the sport. Going outside of the bordering parishes is not allowed by CYO rule, unless, that sport, is not offered by the bordering parishes. All forms required to play outside of the parish must be signed off by, the Pastor and / or Athletic Director at Holy Family.
  4. There should never be dual parish membership in order to participate in CYO athletics at any another parish. If that situation does occur it needs to be reported to the CYO office in Detroit for their office to determine what parish the athlete has to participate at for the remainder of the school year for all sports.
  5. There cannot be dual participation of the same sport in the same season. The loss of CYO eligibility is immediate and all contests played while participating on multiple teams of the same sport will result in game forfeiture up to that point in time.
  6. The Holy Family CYO program would like to give all boys and girls an opportunity to participate in CYO athletics. However to be fair to coaches, those trying out, school sports programs and club teams, it is suggested that you try to decide where you would like to play you athletics. It is not fair to be trying out for 2 or more teams and make those teams then tell a program you are going elsewhere to play. That has then prevented someone from making a team and leaving a team a player short of someone that was going to be counted on as member of that team. If you make a Holy Family team and leave to go play the same sport elsewhere on another team (school or club program) then participation will not be allowed for 1 calendar year from the date of leaving the Holy Family CYO program. If there is someone who leaves the Holy Family CYO program for any other reason that will be handled on a case, by case basis by the athletic director and coaches in considering future Holy Family CYO eligibility.
- If a boy or girls decides to play a sport offered by Holy Family at their school or with their club team they may not practice with the Holy Family CYO teams during the season for that particular sport.
7. Parents must volunteer to work 1 regular season home game. Parent reps with have a list of what coverage is needed for home dates.
  8. For girl's teams there has to be a locker room mom to stay in the dressing area when there is not a female coach for that team. The locker room mom will stay in the locker room when there are male coaches present in the locker room at all times.
  9. CYO participation fee will be \$65 per participant / \$165 max per family
  10. Uniforms must be returned on the scheduled date of return. If the uniform is not returned on the scheduled date, the cost of the uniform will charged to that team member. If the uniform is returned the cost of uniform will be removed from the team member responsibility. If a new uniform is purchased to replace a uniform, that team member will be responsible for the cost of a new uniform.
